I do not support LD227. It's apparent that this bill is designed to protect providers of abortion and transgender "care" from litigation. The risks are high when one performs an abortion at 9 months or starts cutting and mutilating a young person's body inducing sterilization for life. This bill also legally protects providers from violating parent's and legal guardian's rights, not only in Maine, but across the country.
