LD 2077 would help prospective buyers in a financially moderate way that could be just enough to enable them to more readily pursue homeownership.

MAR encourages public support of homeownership and real estate investments through state advantages. We support tax deductions, credits, and grants that encourage private investment in real estate and homeownership.
