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SUMMARY

This amendment removes the requirement to develop with stakeholder input a 3-tiered rate for medication management. It specifies that the 25% increase on medication management is on the rates in place on January 1, 2019 to reflect that the reimbursement rates for some providers of medication management were increased pursuant to Public Law 2019, chapter 616, but that increase was less than 25%. It requires the Department of Health and Human Services to apply a cost-of-living increase to adjust reimbursement rates every 5 years. It also replaces the appropriations and allocations section.
