This amendment adds members to the stakeholder group covered by the long-term care ombudsman program to consider and make recommendations for the implementation of an assessment measure for the needs of family caregivers. It adds representatives of hospitals, home care providers and a statewide organization representing home care providers. It also corrects the emergency preamble to reflect that the long-term care ombudsman program is not within the Department of Health and Human Services.
