My name is Kristi Reynolds. I believe supporting DSPs with 125% of minimum wage is needed in order to attract and keep employees in this field. The lower wages affect our ability to hire and retain DSPs. We see a lot of DSP turnover. The turnover makes it difficult for our program to grow and provide more services. Turnover is also hard for our members as they become attached to the DSPs they see regularly. I would like to see the rate for DSPs to increase. Great Bay Services has already increased the starting wage for our DSPs. We need the state to increase the rate for CPS in order to support the wage that is needed to keep good DSPs. This will attract more and better candidates, help retain the DSPs, allow for them to live and afford paying their bills.
