LD 1550: An Act To End the Sale of Flavored Tobacco Products Testimony of Sara McConnell, Lubec, Maine May 7, 2021

I also lost my two grandmothers and a grandfather to smoking related illnesses. I am so grateful that I no longer smoke. And I'm so proud of my Mom, who on her birthday June 1st, will be smoke free for 10 years! My brother still smokes, I really worry about my niece and nephew. Flavors hook Maine kids - let's put an end to flavored tobacco!
