LD 1653, Resolve, Regarding Legislative Review of Chapter 124: Emergency Medical Services Personnel Reporting Rule, a Late-filed Major Substantive Rule of the Department of Health and Human Services, Maine Center for Disease Control and Prevention (Meyer)

SUMMARY: This resolve is emergency legislation. It provides for legislative review of Chapter 124: Emergency Medical Services Personnel Reporting Rule, a major substantive rule of the Department of Health and Human Services, Maine Center for Disease Control and Prevention that was filed outside the legislative rule acceptance period. It establishes requirements for EMS organizations and emergency medical dispatch centers to monitor and report information about the status of EMS personnel who are absent from duty during an extreme public health emergency, as a result of their exposure or potential exposure to a notifiable disease or condition.
