My name is Nancy Norton and I live in Portland. My husband lost his job of 11 years as a Simulation Specialist at Maine Medical for not getting one of the still EUA covid "vaccines". My husband Todd was recruited for this position. He started the Simulation Center and took great pride in serving Maine Health. Todd was given a medical exemption from his doctor that Maine Medical Center denied. For us there was no choice on our decision. Taking a vaccine that his doctor worried he would react poorly to and that has not had long term testing was not an option. My husband was not granted Unemployment due to the mandate. We are now financially struggling to make ends meet. He was our families main bread winner.
