Dear Honorable members of the Committee for Health and Human Services,

I write to you today to share that I support this bill. It is common sense and respectful of the scientific method.

In my research on this topic I have found limited resources, data, and studies on the actual safety data to support that they are safe and effective. The CDC declares consistently that the vaccines are safe and effective. Yet I have seen more reliable and respect worthy studies showing that there are dangers; showing the risk-benefit ratio to be marginal if non existent, especially for children; showing natural immunity to be the best defense against recurring infection, and most disturbingly, there are 20,000 deaths due to the Covid 19 Vaccinations reported to VAERS as of this week, and hundreds of thousands of serious injuries. This is too great a cost. The responsible and safest action is to slow down the mass vaccination to minimize damage to the population until proper studies can be done.

The Omicron variant is a much less virulent variant than Delta or Sars -Cov2 and the risk for death and serious injury is minimal at this time. It is true, more people are testing positive because it is highly infectious, but it is being compared to the flue and to the yearly colds we are all used to at this time.

We need to have common sense. Automobiles are dangerous, we get in every day knowing there is a small risk of injury or death. Studies are done every year and repeatedly on safety so we all know what the risk to benefit ratios are. We deserve the same safety studies and objective access to information with the vaccines that we have with other products. I need more studies on the actual numbers of people who have died from vaccine injury, and those that have been injured. It is under-reported and this should be of great concern to all of us.

Therefor I support this bill and hope that we can pause and assess risk benefit ratios with better data and make sure that we have accounted properly for all of the injuries and deaths that have occurred due to vaccination. It is highly disturbing that we are not more concerned about those that have died due to vaccination, and those that have been injured. More than 20,000 people are recorded as dead due to the Covid 19 vaccine. They were told it was safe and effective. They were told to take it to protect themselves and others. Now they are dead. This is clearly not a safe and effective product when causing this many deaths, and hundreds of thousands of serious injuries.

It is time to stop and assess the damage.

Thank you for considering my opinions. I know this is a hotly debated issue. My concern is solely to be on the right of science, to be accurate, and make sure that those who have died are not forgotten, and those in the future are protected against the same fate.
