Dear Senator Claxon, Representative Meyer and esteemed committee members,

Please consider this written testimony urging you to vote ought to pass LD 867:

An Act to Prohibit Mandatory Covid-19 Vaccinations for 5 years to Allow for Safety Testing and Investigation into Reproductive Harm.

John F. Kennedy said, “...*a nation that is afraid to let its people judge the truth and falsehood in an open manner is a nation that is afraid of its people.*”

LD 867 is a call for Maine to move in the direction of science, transparency, and non-partisan open investigation.

We need time to investigate the safety of COVID – 19 vaccinations.

This is what we are asking you for – just time.

Please vote ought to pass LD 867 which would go a long way into restoring so many Mainers trust in our government to see past partisanship into the nonpartisan spirit of what scientific investigation and the democratic process is all about.
