MNPA is testifying in support of what we believe is the intent of the amended version of LD 811. Our belief is that this amended bill intends to provide a funding rebasing effort for family planning organizations throughout Maine in a similar way as LD 1787 did for Maine's Federal Qualified Health Centers.

Naturally, when family planning services are discussed, we think of birth control, contraceptives, STDs and UTIs however, the reality is that family planning services provide so much more, and in many parts of Maine serve as the main primary healthcare provider for both men and women. These healthcare services are often provided at a lower cost and help keep patients out of higher cost alternatives such as emergency departments and provide continuity of care.

We are all aware of the provider shortages in Maine and often long wait times to get appointments for basic healthcare services.
