

1. Introduction

Thank you for choosing a Link Cargo Management Products (CMP) SS150/SS150XL single deck system. We want to help you to get the best results from the deck and to operate it safely. This manual contains information to introduce you to the Link CMP SS150/SS150XL and to assist you with its installation. This manual is intended solely for use with this product.

All information in this manual is based on the latest information available at the time of printing. Link reserves the right to change its products or manuals at any time without notice. Contact Link CMP at (800) 248-3057 for information on recent changes to products.

Defective or damaged components should be returned to Link with a pre-arrange Returned Goods Autorization (RGA) number through the Customer Service department. The defective or damaged component(s) may then be replaced if in compliance with warranty conditions.

Review the **Parts Lists** on **Pages 8-12** to become familiar with the different components of the **SS150**. Be sure all items were included before beginning installation. A deck, hardware kit, bier pin, and ramp kit should be included.

2. Installation

- 2.1 The **SS150** is shipped with the bier pin and hardware kit attached to the deck. Remove these items and set aside for later use.
- 2.2 The ramp assembly is installed backwards for shipping. To remove the ramp, position it in the raised position. One side of the ramp is held in place with a pressure-fit while the other is contained. Remove the ramp by carefully lifting the ramp up until the hinge disengages. Slide the ramp away from the other hinge to disengage the ramp from the deck. Reverse and reinstall the ramp assembly as shown on Page 1.
- 2.3 On 1994-2006 vehicle models, remove the rear seats, and fold the middle seats per the owners manual.
 - 2.3.1 The SS150 is held down using existing fastener holes from the cargo hold-downs. Remove the cargo hold-downs and their fasteners using the supplied Torx key. Place in a labeled bag and store in appropriate location for later use. (FIG. 2)
 - 2.3.2 Position the deck inside the vehicle with approximately a 1" gap between the rear of the deck and the seal lip on the door frame. Center the deck between the wheel wells. Align the mounting holes in the rear portion of the deck with the cargo loop mount holes in the vehicle's floor.

- 2.3.3 Verify the deck location by checking the *ramp assembly* for function. Check for fit with the bumper and verify clearance with all parts of the vehicle. Re-position the deck if needed.
- 2.3.4 Secure the deck by inserting the supplied button head screws through the deck and into the cargo loop mount holes in the vehicle floor. Tighten the fasteners using the supplied hex key.
- 2.3.5 Recheck the *ramp assembly* for proper operation.



2.4 On 2007-2014 model year vehicles,

One front support is needed to compensate for a height variation between the second and third rows. Install the support at the front of the deck using the fasteners supplied in the hardware kit (71353001).

2007-2014 model year vehicles require the removal of both rows of rear seats.

- 2.4.1 Remove the third row per the owners manual.
- 2.4.2 To remove the second row, fold the seat into it's stored position per the owners manual.
- 2.4.3 The base of the seat has a carpetcovered cover held in place by Velcro strips. Remove the cover by lifting up and to the rear. This will expose the base of the seat. (FIG. 3)
- 2.4.4 Remove the eight nuts (four per side) secureing the seat using a 3/4" socket. Place the nuts in a labeled bag and store In an appropriate location for later use in the event of removal of the deck and re-installation of the seats.
- 2.4.5 Return the seat to the down position but with the seat back folded. Remove the seat by lifting straight up on the base and extracting the unit out the vehicle door.

NOTE: that if the vehicle is equiped with a bench seat, the seat will need to be extracted out the rear of the vehicle.

- 2.4.6 The SS150 is held down using existing fastener holes from the cargo hold-downs. Remove the cargo hold-downs and their fasteners using the supplied Torx key. Place in a labeled bag and store in appropriate location for later use.
- 2.4.7 Position the deck inside the vehicle with approximately a 1" gap between the rear of the deck and the seal lip on the door frame. Center the deck between the wheel wells. Align the mounting holes in the rear portion of the deck with the cargo loop mount holes in the vehicle's floor.

- 2.4.8 Verify the deck location by checking the *ramp assembly* for function. Check for fit with the bumper and verify clearance with all parts of the vehicle. Re-position the deck if needed.
- 2.4.9 Secure the deck by inserting the supplied button head screws through the deck and into the cargo loop mount holes in the vehicle floor. Tighten the fasteners using the supplied hex key.
- 2.4.10 Recheck the *ramp assembly* for proper operation.



2.5 <u>On 2015-2020 model year vehicles with seats</u> installed,


A support channel needs to be installed in the rear cargo area with fasteners supplied in kit (71351011).

The rear cargo organizer will need to be removed.

- 2.5.1 Open the organizer, remove the cargo partitions, lift the two rubber mats at the bottom of the organizer, remove the two fasteners, and lift and remove cargo organizer. (FIG. 4 / FIG. 5)
- 2.5.2 Center the rear mount assembly in the rear cargo area with arrow facing forward, align over the infloor nuts. Using a 13mm socket tighten the two M8 X 1.25 X 20 hex bolts into place.
- 2.5.3 Slide the SS150 into the rear of the vehicle. Align forward most holes with the rear mount assembly. Tighten the two M 10 X 1.5 X 80 button head screws to using th 6mm hex key supplied. (FIG. 6)
- 2.5.10 Recheck the *ramp assembly* for proper operation.







2.6 On 2015-2020 model year vehicles with seats removed,

One front support is needed to compensate for a height variation between the second and third rows. Install the support at the front of the deck using the fasteners supplied in the hardware kit (71353001).

2007-2014 model year vehicles require the removal of both rows of rear seats.

2.6.1 Open the organizer, remove the cargo partitions, lift the two rubber mats at the bottom of the organizer, remove the two fasteners, and lift and remove cargo organizer. (FIG. 7 / FIG. 8)





2.6.2 Remove the third row seats remove the eight 19mm bolts. Remove the seat by lifting straight up on the base and extracting the unit out the rear vehicle hatch.

- 2.6.3 To remove the second row, fold the seat into it's stored position per the owners manual.
- 2.6.4 The base of the seat has a carpetcovered cover held in place by Velcro strips. Remove the cover by lifting up and to the rear. This will expose the base of the seat. (FIG. 9)




2.6.5 Remove the eight nuts (four per side) secureing the seat using a 19mm socket. Place the nuts in a labeled bag and store In an appropriate location for later use in the event of removal of the deck and re-installation of the seats.

2.6.6 Return the seat to the down position but with the seat back folded. Remove the seat by lifting straight up on the base and extracting the unit out the vehicle door.

NOTE: that if the vehicle is equiped with a bench seat, the seat will need to be extracted out the rear of the vehicle.

2.6.7 The SS150 is held in place using the existing seat fasteners and 12mm nuts. (FIG. 10)





2.7 On 2021 and newer model year vehicles.

A support bracket needs to be installed in the place of the rear cargo organizer (71353008).

The rear cargo organizer will need to be removed.


- 2.7.1 Open the organizer, remove the four fasteners, and lift and remove the cargo organizer. (FIG.11)
- 2.7.2 Place (1) 1/2" washer around each of the four cargo organizer studs to distribute the weight of the deck across the vehicle floor.
- 2.7.3 Position the mount bracket on the four studs. Place (1) 1/4" washer, (1) 6mm lock washer, and (1) 6mm nut on each stud. Do not over tighten the nuts.
- 2.7.4 Position the deck into the vehicle.
 Using the middle mount hole, secure to the mount bracket using (2) 3/8" bolts and (2) 3/8" flange bolts. (FIG. 12)






3. Maintenance






