Re: An Amendment to LD 992 –

*“An Act to Prevent the Denial or Revocation of a Professional or Business
License for a Violation Not Related to That Profession or Business”*

Sponsored by Representative Daniel Newman

Amend LD 992:

*So that it Prevents Denial or Revocation of a Professional or Business License
for a Violation Not Related to that Profession or Business with Certain
Exceptions.*

(May Remove the Notwithstanding Language)

Exceptions:

- A. *The reason for denial or revocation is listed on the license application or
renewal application.*
- B. *If the business or individual is under investigation of a suspected crime or for a
listed revocation or denial item listed on the application.*
- C. *The individual is convicted of a felony or the business has been sound in
violation of state law or local ordinance pertaining to that business.*
- D. *There are statutes in existing law that allow denial or revocation of that
license.*
