21	3. Location and access. The analysis, recommendations and research results gathered
22	pursuant to this subchapter must be maintained by the institute at the University of Maine
23	and must be available for use by any interested group or individual.
24	SUMMARY
25	This bill establishes the Maine Workforce, Research, Development and Student
26 27	Achievement Institute and a related steering committee to advise the Legislature on matters related to workforce training, research and development, student debt and economic
27	advancement in the State. The bill describes the 18 required steering committee members
29	and establishes that each member, other than ex officio members, serves a 2-year term and
30	that the steering committee meets at least 4 times per year.
