

Testimony of Geri Vistein

Senator Dill, Representative Landry and committee members

My name is Geri Vistein and I am here today to express my lack of support for LD1054: Having to do with allowing Hunting on Sunday.

If I recall, it was just two years ago that a bill similar to this came before the committee, attempting to make it legal to hunt on Sundays. Mainers from all backgrounds came out in force against it.
