I support this bill due to the following concerns with wake boats:

- The real possibility that wake boats will transfer invasive water plants from infected lakes to one such as Echo Lake which is still pristine.
- The erosion and damage to property around the lakes due to the constant bombardment of wakes from passing wake boats specifically the expense of maintaining Echo Lake road and the replacement or repair to docks.
- Concerns on how the wake boats are impacting wildlife on the lakes; specifically the common loon, who nests very close to the water. The wake boats are most active and prevalent during the nesting season.
- Safety concerns for those swimming, kayaking, canoeing and paddleboarding while wake boats are in operation.

I want to be sure that our lake stays pristine and is a place where people can continue to enjoy the beauty and activities for which Maine is known.
