Dear Senator LaFountain, Representative Landry, and distinguished members of the Committee on Inland Fisheries and Wildlife.

My name is Wendy Molin, wendymolin@gmail.com, and I spend five to six months per year at my home on Kezar Lake. I am asking for your support for LD693, the bill that poses sensible restrictions for wake boats. Prohibiting the use of wake boats within 500 feet of shore and in less than 20 feet water is reasonable.

Wakes created closer to shore than 500 feet create waves that can hasten erosion of the shoreline, disturb loon nesting areas, pose danger to small children and pets, and disturb kayakers and canoers. Wake boats operating in less than 20 feet of water can stir up the lake bottom, disturbing aquatic life and potentially causing algae blooms as phosphorous is displaced and redistributed. This danger really scares me: I know everyone will be saddened if rules are not put in place before an irreversible problem starts.

Please vote for LD693. We all deserve to share the beauty and enjoy the beautiful lakes in Maine.
