**RE: LD 2023 – Resolve, to Establish a Working Group to Identify Ways to Manage Moorings on Inland Waters**

MMTA represents over 120 Maine businesses and an industry comprised of boatyards, boat builders, marinas, boat dealers, and marine retailers.

On behalf of the members of MMTA, I would like to express our appreciation and support for the Department's proposed resolve to address issues regarding moorings in Maine waters. Though the stakeholders will be focused on inland waters, we hope the report back to the Committee will note mooring issues that overlap in coastal waters. The Maine coast does have islands within the Unorganized Territory and others that are more remote without much municipal oversight.
