I will be testifying in support of the legislation. Since my original divorce judgement was issued in August 2016. A 6 month PFA was also granted at that time. In February of 2017, Andrea Mancuso, who at the time was working at Pine Tree Legal represented me in extending the PFA. I have the transcripts from that time. Judge Darvin did not extend the order because of the way in which the original order was written. My ex-husband was representing himself after the divorce and used terms like "you are raping Danielle in attorney fees" and a number of other comments. In 2021, I was accused of parental alienation and went through a four day trial. He hired parental alienation witnesses to testify. My thirteen year old daughter was forced to testify after her therapist was deposed and his attorney attempted to subpoena her counseling records forcing my daughter's therapist to hire an attorney. I was not found guilty and was awarded 30,000 in attorney fees.
