LD: 677 “An Act to Update the Statutory Definition of “Machine Gun” and Prohibit Possession of a Rapid-fire Device”

To the Honorable Members of the 132nd Maine State Legislature:

This is a direct copy of last year’s ill-conceived proposal that was vetoed by Governor Mills. Federal law already provides a definition for “machine gun” which has been long standing and worked fine for the state’s purposes for close to a century. This proposal has no focus on public safety and instead seeks to question what responsible gun owners may or may not possess, and works against the promise to the Maine people afforded by Article 1, Section 16 of our great state’s constitution.
