LD 1049 An Act to Eliminate the Duty to Inform a Law Enforcement Officer When Carrying a Concealed Handgun Without a Permit Please vote "Ought to Pass" this proposal.

The current provision serves no practical purpose and does nothing to enhance public safety. Those who intend to do harm will not follow it, while responsible gun owners are left navigating an unnecessary legal hurdle. Rather than providing any real benefit, this law simply creates an unnecessary risk of entrapment for those exercising their constitutional rights.
