Legislative Document No. 1007 An Act to Update the State's Informed Consent Laws Regarding Drug-induced Abortion

In your position guiding decisions relevant to the health and welfare of your constituents, I submit to you the encouragement to enact all content of 2 Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §1599-A, sub-§3.
