## To Members of the Joint Standing Committee on Judiciary

Regarding L.D. 975, "An Act to Repeal Laws Allowing Abortion and to Criminalize Abortion"

I support LD 975, "An Act to Repeal Laws Allowing Abortion and to Criminalize Abortion."
