This bill is not about safety—it's about fear. It targets transgender women and tries to rewrite Maine's human rights law to justify exclusion in sports and shelters. Let's be clear: trans women are not a threat—they are women. They are people trying to survive, thrive, and be treated with the dignity they deserve.

LD 1337 tells trans girls they can't play. It tells trans women in crisis they have nowhere to go. That's not protection—it's punishment. And it flies in the face of everything Maine's Human Rights Act is supposed to stand for.
