Dear Judiciary Committee Members,

My name is Camille Hoffman and I live in Sullivan, Maine. I am writing to oppose LD 868 and all related bills being heard on May 8, 2025 because they discriminate against transgender girl athletes in school. Discrimination like this is not just harmful to transgender people, but decisions like these set precedents and ripple out to every other marginalized group of people and their families and friends.

These bills do nothing to protect girls or improve women's sports, in fact it would harm all girls and likely prevent many girls from participating in sports at all, as the enforcement of these bills would put ALL girl athletes through intrusive inspections that would put girls health and safety at risk.

Maine has long protected its LGBTQ community against discrimination. Now is not the time to roll back those protections. I urge you to vote NO on all of the following bills: LD 233, LD 380, LD 868, LD 1002, LD 1134, LD 1337, LD 1432 and LD 1704.
