Testimony in Opposition to LD 380 Katherine Marble, LCSW Resident of Temple, Maine

Dear Senator Carney, Representative Kahn and honorable Members of the Judiciary Committee,

My name is Katherine Marble, and I am a Licensed Clinical Social Worker. I am writing to express my strong opposition to LD 380, An Act to Amend Certain Laws Prohibiting Gender-Affirming Care.

Gender-affirming care encompasses a range of medical, psychological, and social services that help individuals align their gender identity with their physical appearance or social roles. This care is evidence-based, patient-centered, and widely supported by major medical and mental health organizations, including the American Medical Association, the American Academy of Pediatrics, and the American Psychiatric Association.
