Subject: Opposition to Restrictions on Gender-Affirming Health Care

Dear Members of the Judiciary Committee,

I am writing as a concerned resident of Maine to strongly oppose LD 380, which would restrict access to gender-affirming health care for youth.

I have a young cousin, born and raised in southern Maine, who will soon turn three. According to the American Academy of Pediatrics, most children begin to develop a stable sense of their gender identity between the ages of 2 and 4. Some of these children—including my cousin and peers in daycare—will grow up to tell us they are cisgender. Some will grow up to tell us they are transgender. All deserve access to the health care they may need to feel safe, affirmed, and whole.

Gender-affirming care is not experimental or fringe. It is recognized as evidence-based, effective, and often life-saving by major medical organizations, including the American Medical Association.
