Since 2011, sensitive locations such as schools, hospitals, and places of worship have been off-limits to most immigration enforcement activities. That policy was revoked in 2025 and now, families across Maine -- regardless of their immigration status -- are afraid to take their kids to school or go to the doctor.

LD 2106 would restore these protections by:

- ✓ Requiring ICE to get a judge-signed warrant before enforcement at schools, hospitals, daycares, and libraries
- ✓ Protecting personal information at these locations
- ✓ Giving clear guidance to teachers and healthcare workers so they're not forced into impossible situations

Please consider voting yes on LD 2106 for the safety of ALL of Maine's citizens. Because when one of us isn't safe, none of us are safe.
