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I work at a medical center in Portland, Maine and perform life-saving and life-sustaining treatments. I am not specifying which type to protect the patients we serve. We perform regular treatments on patients in the community who are immigrants. One of these patients has missed multiple visits due to the realistic fear that they will be detained either on the way to the facility or while there. Many other patients have expressed the same fears due to their skin being non-white. Patients should not be deferring important medical interventions, which could prove lethal, due to the threat of detention by ICE. This is especially true for the very places designed to help and treat Mainers, regardless of their immigration status, citizenship, race, ethnicity
