Do not advance this legislation, which is anti-trans bigotry. This should go without saying, but trans people exist, including trans children. Every credible medical association in the U.S. agrees with that statement, and they unequivocally advocate for affirming trans identity. Trans people don't pose some inherent danger; cis girls don't need "protection" from their trans peers. Some claim that segregating children's sports teams by sex assigned at birth is about ensuring "fairness," which presumes two things: 1) that all youths assigned male at birth are inherently better at sports than all youths assigned female at birth, and 2) that preventing this purported unfairness justifies very real & onerous discrimination against trans youths. I find the first presumption dubious but the second absolutely despicable. This bill is moral panic nonsense. Leave trans kids alone.
