Dear Maine Judiciary Committee, evaluating LD 2239:

Please adopt a justice based competing measure for this proposed legal change.

This should include:

1. Womens Rights are Human Rights and Human Rights are Women's Rights. No more so named 'trans' stealing women's rights.. XY plays with XY. XX plays with XX. No one is playing according to their imagination in an unregulated US where values of money and power dominate. EAsy oral swab for anyone who questions this and easy answer.. Biologically, XY is stronger because for 11 years they are bathed in testosterone.. Currently, 51% of the US population, women, XX, have had their bodily autonomy stolen and the promise of equality rots. I wrote last year to School Supervisors, mostly white men of course, here in Maine, who don't care that young women are loosing opportunities in sports leadership. However, many of us women, do care. Stop taking our rights.
2. A MS Magazine article detailing 'pain' to 'trans XYs' who (as aggressors), when this issue was prior discussed in the 1980s, refused to live by standards for all folks. They 'might' suicide. A few did. Statistically, gender confusion is complex, at times versatile, with mental health challenges common in an intolerant society like the US. This can be avoided with more compassion for all, including disabled children, Veterans, folks of color and clear explanations that 'we do not take rights from one group (women, 51% of the population), just because a tiny minority (self named trans, .01%) want to steal the rights of others to gain winning. NEVER, do we hear that these trans want to play with XY. Aggressors, XY, want to WIN. It's easier if you are biologically stronger. Once again, XX in the US are SCREWED.

3. A NY woman sued her therapist/US surgeons who performed sex change surgery on her at the age of 16. Patient had insisted on this. Now, however, with irreversible biological changes, and unwelcome lifelong symptoms of the changes, she successfully sued medical professionals for millions this winter. 'She did not truly understand the consequences'... HMNNNNN.... In an unregulated social media society, where college age kids have been in school shooting twice already in this violent and vile society, where selfishness reigns supreme, Epstein elite use any and all of us for their pleasures and funding, no children should be making these life changing decisions.
