Senator Tipping, Representative Roeder and Honorable Members of the Joint Labor Committee

I appreciate this opportunity to address you on this important matter. My name is Anne Gallaudet. I am a resident of Scarborough, Maine. I am writing *in opposition of* LD 1221.

The Maine's Paid Family and Medical Leave Program (PFML) was created by statute and now exists as a matter of law. How collected funds are to be used are prescribed by the authorizing statute. See Title 26, 850-E, Paid Family and Medical Leave Insurance Fund.

Thus, this bill does nothing more than: (1) propose a waste of taxpayers' money to the tune of over \$341,000 (see fiscal statement accompanying this bill) as the PFML authorizing statute has already addressed this issue; (2) confuse the public by suggesting the collected money could be used otherwise when the statute is already clear on this matter; and (3) wrongly turn this matter into one needing a *constitutional* solution which is inappropriate even if there was such a problem as alleged (which there is not).
