While the Department is not testifying in person on this bill, we wanted to provide a brief letter in regard to LD 898, An Act To Provide Incentives to Unemployed Workers To Become Part of the Caregiver Workforce.

Currently, the Department is still reviewing the language of the proposal but recognizes there would be broad implications for the Department's Bureau of Unemployment Compensation and Bureau of Employment Services. We are reviewing the legislation and will provide more substantive comments for the work session. Since the bill interacts with the Unemployment Compensation system, the Department has sent the proposal to USDOL for further review and can provide that information as it is available.
