Sen. Daughtry, Rep. Sylvester, and members of the Labor and Housing Committee, thank you for the opportunity to appear before you today. I'm Penny Morrell, Chairman of the Belgrade Republican Party.

I oppose L.D. 2003, "An Act To Implement the Recommendations of the Commission To Increase Housing Opportunities in Maine by Studying Zoning and Land Use Restrictions."
