

Support of LD 111: An Act Requiring the State to Pay a Share of a Retired State Employee's or Retired Teacher's Premium for Medicare Part B Under Medicare Advantage

On behalf of MADSEC, I am providing testimony in support of LD 111.

LD 111 identifies pension differences among teachers and seeks to establish a sliding scale per se based on the amount of the individual's retirement benefit to assist retired teachers with healthcare costs.

MADSEC supports LD 111 given the financial burden on retired teachers to pay Medicare Part B premiums from their pensions, which were affected by cuts in 2011.
