LD 1220, An Act To Require a Two-thirds Vote of the Legislature Every 2 Weeks To Maintain a State of Emergency Declared by the Governor - Rep. John Andrews of Paris

LD 1237, An Act To Allow the Governor To Declare a Limited State of Emergency for Federal Aid Purposes - Sen. Lisa Keim of Oxford
