SUMMARY

This bill makes changes to the laws governing compensation, reimbursements and allowances for Legislators.

1. Beginning with the 131st Legislature, it increases the salary of Legislators from an estimated \$15,954 in the first year and \$11,125 in the 2nd year of a biennium, after adjustment for inflation, to \$20,000 in each year of the biennium.

2. It increases the mileage allowance for Legislators from 44ϕ per mile to the lower of the federal mileage rate or 56ϕ per mile.

3. Beginning with the 131st Legislature, it changes the lodging rate for Legislators. Currently, the lodging rate is \$38 per day; this bill changes the rate to an amount determined annually by the Legislative Council, which must be no less than the lower of the average nightly rate of lodging in the Augusta area and the federal per diem rate for lodging.

4. Beginning with the 131st Legislature, it provides a weekly allowance of \$250 for any week during a period of national emergency or civil emergency in which a Legislator is required to work remotely, attends an authorized committee meeting and does not otherwise travel to the State House.
