I am Barbara Fortier, native Mainer, life-long resident of Biddeford, and Secretary on the Board of the Maine Lighthouse Trust.

I ask that you please pass the act to create the Maine Lighthouse Trust Registration Plate, LD 266.

As you know, lighthouses have played a vital role in our state's maritime history since construction began on Maine's first at Portland Head in 1787. Today, more than 230 years later, lighthouses continue to aid in safe navigation of our coastal waters, as well as inspire tourism and fascination with our state's history and the lighthouse-keeper heritage of lore.
