LD 899 - An Act To Protect Privacy and Security at the Bureau of Motor Vehicles

SUMMARY:

This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208. This bill proposes to enact measures designed to protect the privacy and security of an individual's personal information at the Department of the Secretary of State, Bureau of Motor Vehicles.

TESTIMONY:

Proponents: Rep. O'Neil, Secretary of State

- Requested to carry this bill over to the second regular session of the 130th Legislature in order to have enough time to accurately assess the needs of the Bureau and how to effectively and efficiently utilize the law and best practices to ensure strong privacy protections and records management.
- Over the next several months, the Secretary of State plans to work with the bill sponsor, and staff at the Bureau of Motor Vehicles (including a new Chief Information Officer who will be joining the Department in the coming weeks) and other data privacy experts to assess where the bureau is in data privacy, what improvements need to be made and which of those improvements will require legislation.
