I'm a regular user of the initial phase of the trail that runs through Fryeburg, and I'm very excited at the possibilities I believe it will bring to Brownfield and other rural towns along the route.

I support LD 676 because:

- 1. In 2021, Maine DOT's Rail Use Advisory Council (RUAC) voted 11:1 for the conversion of 31 miles of existing railroad track to an interim trail-until-rail.
- 2. In July of 2023, LD 404 codified into law the recommendations of the RUAC
- 3. Over 200 people offered testimony and letters in support of LD 404.
- 4. LD 676 will allow MDOT to spend federal grant funding on building the trail from Fryeburg to Standish, thereby bringing substantial economic development opportunities to this rural area.
