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I would like to add my support to the passage of this bill, which would give our Ferry Advisory Board representatives more of an impact in the development of MSFS budget planning, and scheduling. Despite input from Swans Island Elementary School Board Members, Principal, and Superintendent as well as the Director of Services of the health center, and the SelectBoard, both the Elementary School and the Mill Pond Health Center have had to decrease services due to MSFS ignoring the needs of the Swan's Island community in the creation of the current schedule, confirming the need for increased community input. My hope is that this bill would allow for some compromise when the schedules are created, and provide the necessary oversight to ensure the community's needs are fully considered.
