Summary	This bill increases the number of mature plants from 30 to 60 and the number of immature plants from 60 to 120 that a medical marijuana caregiver may cultivate.

LD 421	Current Law
B. Cultivate up to 30 <u>60</u> mature marijuana plants or 500 square feet of plant canopy, 60 <u>120</u> immature marijuana plants and unlimited seedlings;	<u>22 MRSA §2423-A</u> 2. Caregiver. Except as provided in <u>section 2426</u> , a caregiver, for the purpose of assisting a qualifying patient with the patient's medical use of marijuana, may engage in the following authorized conduct if the caregiver is a resident of the State, is 21 years of age or older and has not been convicted of a disqualifying drug offense: ...
