I am a caregiver certified by MOFGA. I grow from seeds that have not been feminized. I start seedlings, about half will be male and half will be female. They will show their sex 4-6 weeks after germination. I can not guarantee how tall they will be when they show their sex. I keep the males to collect pollen so that I can create my own seeds, as organic seeds are difficult to find, and illegal to cross state borders. This would make it illegal for me to keep my males in order to collect pollen. It would also make it potentially illegal for me to properly sex out my plants, and wait until all of them have done so to cull the ones I do not want to plant. Caregivers should also be allowed to sell for remuneration extra plants to patients. That would only make sense.
