

1. In Section A-1 of the bill, page 1, lines 4-12, the definition of “online voter registration application” states that it will be available on the Secretary of State’s publicly accessible website. Section A-12 on page 4, lines 13-17 also states that the online voter registration application that the Secretary of State designs can be submitted online through the Secretary of State’s publicly accessible website. Thus, we believe that variations of the phrase “[on][through] the Secretary of State’s publicly accessible website” in several other places in the bill are duplicative and could be removed. Following is a list of these instances:
  - a. Page 2, lines 10 and 11 “available on the Secretary of State’s publicly accessible website”
  - b. Page 2, lines 26 and 27 “through the Secretary of State’s publicly accessible website”
  - c. Page 2, lines 32 and 33 “through the Secretary of State’s publicly accessible website”
  - d. Page 2, lines 40 and 41 “through the Secretary of State’s publicly accessible website”
  - e. Page 3, lines 4 and 5 “on the Secretary of State’s publicly accessible website”
  - f. Page 3, line 13 “through the Secretary of State’s publicly accessible website”
  - g. Page 3, lines 28 and 29 “through the Secretary of State’s publicly accessible website”
2. Similarly, on page 5, lines 9 and lines 12 and 13, the phrase “online voter registration application” should be substituted for “Secretary of State’s publicly accessible website”
3. Delete paragraph A on page 4, lines 18-21 of the bill (in Section A-12), and further amend paragraph M on page 3, line 40 of the bill (in Section A-10) as follows: “~~;~~ and , except that an applicant may not register to vote using the online voter registration application unless the applicant discloses a current, valid Maine driver’s license number or nondriver identification card number or discloses the last 4 digits of the applicant’s social security number;”
4. Strike Part B (page 5, lines 22-29)
5. Change the implementation date on page 5, line 21 from “January 1, 2023” to “November 1, 2023”
