At one time he was on 19 different prescribed medications and as we know this isn't good for your organs. His kidneys were literally failing him. SmWe have a family member who mentioned the medical marijuana program to him and he is now on not one medication except medical marijuana. He sleeps great eats great his mood is normal again. And he is in pain and always will be but he uses a tincture rub and it helps his pain as well. He also has panic disorder and for a long time he would have panic attacks so bad that everything would go black on him and he would pass out. I can't tell you the last time that he had one of those. It was well over a year ago. The medical marijuana program saved my husbands life. I am also a MMJ card holder I am diagnosed with panic disorder mild depression and a couple other things from childhood trauma. I have officially gone off all my prescriptions as well and I am just using the medical marijuana and my entire quality of life is better. I don't smoke it I use a oil based tincture that I drop under my tongue and it works amazing. I am only able to tell you my story and my husbands story, but there are thousands of people who have had the same experience. Especially our Veterans. The medications they give them literally destroy their liver and kidneys. If they can switch and only have to take (or smoke if they prefer) one thing and it works for it all why shouldn't they? The MMJ program is saving lives and it is also an opportunity for the state of Maine to make some money back that we lost due to COVID. The state of Maine depends on its tourism every summer and we just haven't had it since COVID started. The state could really BOOM financially I'm from this program.
