Sen Luchini Amendment

Statutory Changes:

1. Remove independent audit requirement - §2430-G;
2. Add single card language provided by OMP
3. Allow caregivers to sell plants to patients
4. §2430-G(B) Add language: The “statewide electronic portal” shall not contain the names or dates of birth of qualifying patients

Direct OMP to change rule:

1. Remove video surveillance requirements for home-based caregivers (Rule 11.3.3 (C))
2. Remove security system requirements for home-based caregivers (Rule 11.3.3 (C))
3. Remove lighting requirements (Rule 11.3.3 (A))
4. Remove video and security requirements for caregiver dwelling unit broadly 6.1.3
5. Remove car alarm requirements Rule 7.2.5 (A1b)
6. Remove references to law enforcement
7. Create exemptions for small caregivers from track and trace system – 11.3.4; Not “all”
8. Create more flexible reporting plan for if METRC goes off-line or registrant loses internet
9. Develop specific rules for marijuana tincture and marijuana drink

Other Changes: Statute/Rules:

- Department may not enforce track and trace on retail caregiver storefronts until Jan 1, 2022
- Department may not enforce track and trace on home-based caregivers until June 1, 2022
