Against LD313

An Act to Improve Voter Confidence in Electronic Ballot Counting by Requiring  
Ballots to Contain Unique Identifiers

Dear Committee Chairs Craig Hickman Laura Supica and the honorable members of  
the Veterans and Legal Affairs Committee:

I am Jeanne Marquis from China, Maine, and I am urging this esteemed committee to  
vote NO on LD 313. We do not need any bills that interfere with our Maine voting  
procedures. Voting is our precious right as a citizen and we do not want any  
legislation that hinders access or has the potential for manipulation or malfeasance.

This bill requires each ballot prepared by the Secretary of State to contain a unique  
identifier. This will most likely require new voting devices and printing procedures  
which will mean municipalities will have mandated expenses added to their already  
stretched budgets. I am currently a selectperson for the Town of China and find this  
totally unacceptable.
