Accurate voter lists are the first line of defense for a secure election system. Citizens share a lot of highly sensitive information with the government and the government should always take steps to protect that data.

The Secretary of State can use USPS NCOA data which only requires first name, last name and street address to match to an in state or out of state move. This is a valuable tool that is less expensive if the Secretary run it directly with an NCOA provider. The Secretary can securely obtain SSA death records for free without disclosing any private citizen data.

Lastly, the Secretary can use staff with technical skills and run a comparison in Excel to identify duplicate voter registrations. De-duping the list is something that can be done internally.
