I'm writing in opposition of LD 104. This bill would totally destroy your average medical cannabis farm, some may hold on but I can't see it being sustainable for most. This would cost the farmer an average of \$500 per variety (strain) and this additional charge would force most farmers to limit the varieties they grow. That's not including any additional testing for secondary products (pre rolls for example) made from the same tested flower. Patients rely on the varieties we carry as each provide a different benefit and some patients respond differently than others to certain strains. This will either get passed on to patients or absorbed by the farmer, either way a patient won't be able to afford their medicine or caregivers will go out of business.
