She moved to Portsmouth, New Hampshire and published her first novel, "Maggie's Way," in 1981 and her second novel, "God's Country," in 1987. William Morrow & Company published her nonfiction book about lesbians, "Invisible Lives," in 1989. Her travel memoir, "Slow Travel," was published by Piscataqua Press in 2014.
